VIRTUAL TRAINING

With a focus on **integrating CHWs into behavioral health services**, ABCD offers a four-session virtual course for CHWs working in primary care settings whose patients struggle with substance use and/or mental health issues. This training provides a comprehensive introduction to common mental health and substance use disorders and helps participants to build knowledge and skills based on real life scenarios and case examples .

Trainers are CHWs with lived experience and social workers from health care settings committed to integrating CHWS into behavioral health systems.
