

ENERGY SERVICES

ABCD Energy Services operates two departments that are leading the way to lower costs and a clean energy future. We can help pay your bills, keep you warm in winter, cool in summer, and safer and healthier year-round through innovative decarbonization, energy efficiency and resiliency programs.





ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Our Energy Assistance programs provide financial support through the federal Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), which can lower your heating bills, and utility partner programs that can reduce your gas and electricity costs.

CE&I provides clean, green, energy-efficient systems for income-eligible homes and multi-family apartment buildings and complexes statewide – at no cost. With the help of our partners Eversource, National Grid, the MA Executive Office of Housing and Livable Communities, and many others, ABCD provides a comprehensive, whole building approach to maximize the energy savings, greenhouse gas reductions and comfort in all types of housing.

CONSERVATION

ABCD can often lower electric bills with no cost instant savings measures like energy efficient light bulbs, water conservation measures and possibly upgraded appliances like a new refrigerator, freezer, air conditioner, dehumidifier or front-loading washing machine.

HEATING, VENTILATION AND AIR CONDITIONING (HVAC)

We can replace or repair your inefficient heating system, with a focus on replacing fossil fuel-burning systems (oil and propane) with electric air source heat pumps (ASHP). We scope, design, contract and oversee the installation at no cost to both owners and renters. ASHP technology provides heating on the coldest days, air conditioning on the hottest days, and helps our clients reduce their greenhouse gas emissions and carbon footprint.

WEATHERIZATION

Our Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) helps cut heating and air conditioning costs. We can install attic and wall insulation, weather stripping, air sealing, and in some cases new windows, at no cost.

ELECTRIFICATION, DECARBONIZATION AND RESILIENCY

Our programs are designed to provide a comprehensive suite of energy-saving building upgrades and a pathway to electrification, decarbonization, and resiliency.

FINANCIAL

ABCD makes financial well-being a priority through a free tax preparation program that can help income-eligible taxpayers pay off debt and build savings.



TAX ASSISTANCE

Part of the federal VITA program, our IRS-certified tax preparers help taxpayers receive eligible tax credits such as EITC that maximize your refunds. We also provide a general financial check-up that includes advising on your credit report and tax-time savings options.


